

- 2018 Dr. JP Pinard applies to CERRC on behalf of Paulatuk, NT
- 2020 July 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020 CERRC accepted Wind Heat North's proposal for Paulatuk, NT
- 2021 March 22<sup>nd</sup> 2021, First PEWG Meeting.
- 2021 October 25<sup>th</sup> 2021 the EC Grace Nakimayak was hired by the group.



- Training and Resources to develop locally owned & operated long term renewable energy solutions.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Preliminary Proposals under the CERRC Capacity Building Stream is now open with a submission deadline of 23:59 EDT, March 29, 2019.
Preliminary proposals will be reviewed to determine which projects best meet the objectives of the call.
End of April, 2019
Successful preliminary proposals will be invited to submit a full proposal for funding consideration.
Phase 2: Summer to early fall, 2019
Successful Phase 2 project funding will be available and finalized.
