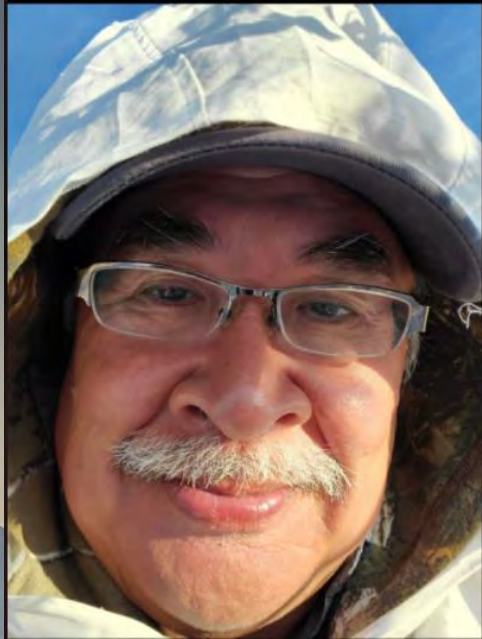

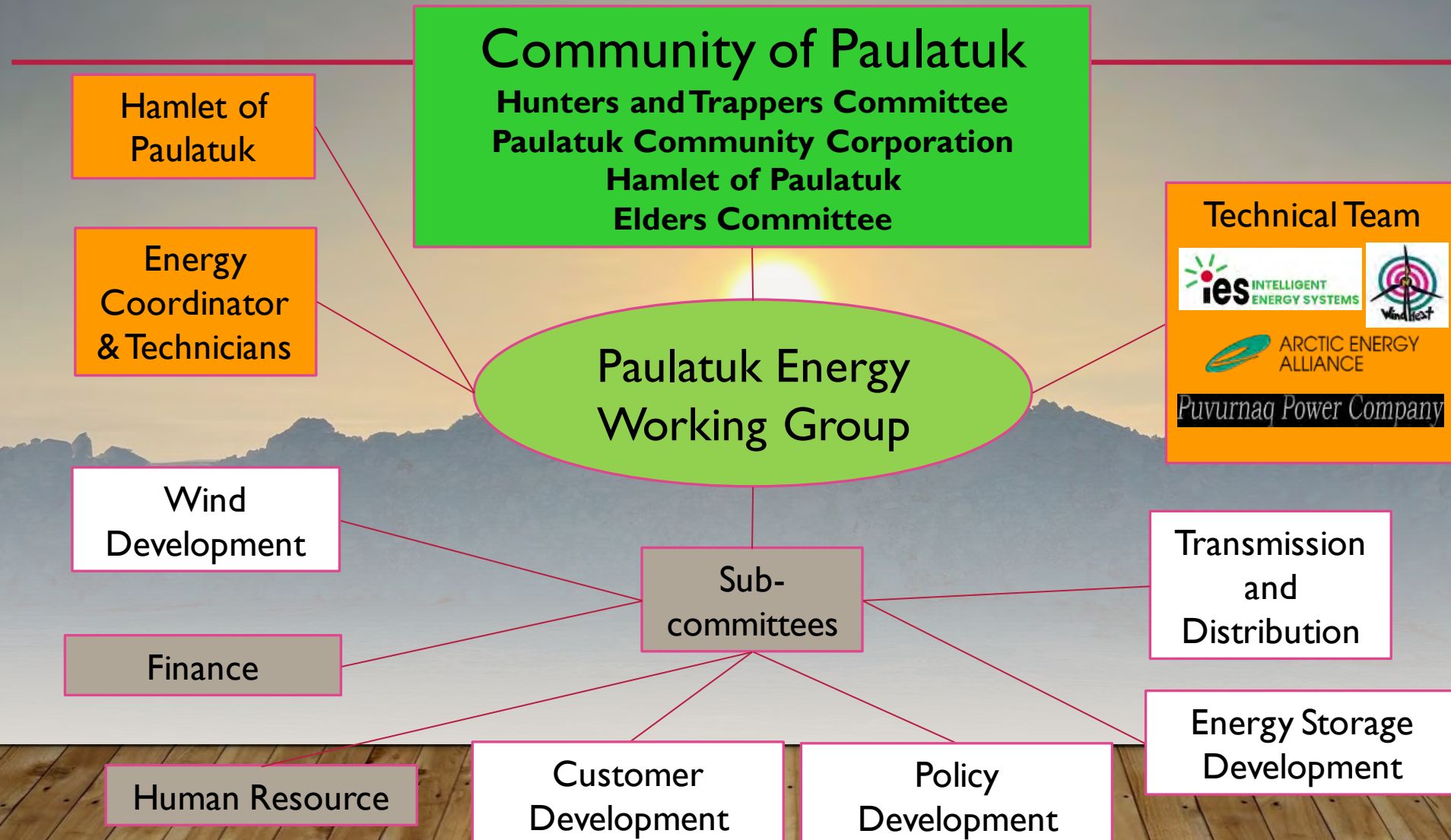

TIMELINE OF THE PEWG

- 2007 - Dr Jean-Paul Pinard met Mayor Raymond Ruben Sr in Tuktoyaktuk, NT.
- 2015 — Raymond Ruben Sr networks with JP Pinard at the RiRC2015 in Yellowknife
- 2018 — Dr.JP Pinard applies to CERRC on behalf of Paulatuk, NT
- 2020 — July 23rd 2020 CERRC accepted Wind Heat North's proposal for Paulatuk, NT
- 2021 — March 22nd 2021, First PEWG Meeting.
- 2021 — October 25th 2021 the EC Grace Nakimayak was hired by the group.

- 2021 – December 6th – December 10th – PEWG held its first Energy Week.
- 2022 – March WHN, iES & EC start Home Energy Survey Training
- 2022 – March 22nd – First PEWG anniversary!

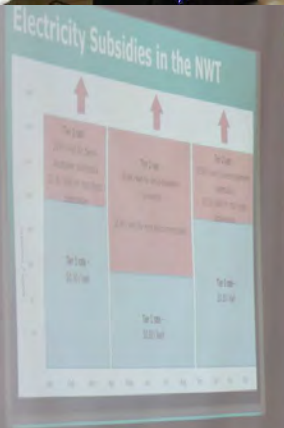

End of April, 2019

Successful preliminary proposals will be invited to submit a full proposal for funding consideration.

Phase 2: Summer to early fall, 2019

Successful Phase 2 project funding will be available and finalized.

This program supports community-level capacity building that will increase clean energy opportunities, including renewables and energy efficiency, and contribute to reducing diesel reliance in rural and/or remote communities.
