

# Key Polling Results


## Conducted between November 30 and December 11, 2020

#### Methodology

Survey questions were administered through the TrendWatch Alberta Omnibus Survey between November 30 and December 11, 2020. TrendWatch Alberta is a monthly omnibus survey of 900 Albertans, ages 18 and over. The margin of error for a probability sample of 900 people is plus or minus 3.3 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 (i.e., at a 95% confidence interval).

#### a) Alberta's economy will benefit if the oil and gas industry reduces emissions

23% Strongly agree

38% Somewhat agree

21% Somewhat disagree

13% Strongly disagree

5% Don't know / No answer

Overall, 61% agree while 34% disagree.

#### b) Alberta's economy is too dependent on oil and gas

- 45% Strongly agree
- 36% Somewhat agree
- 10% Somewhat disagree
- 8% Strongly disagree
- 1% Don't know / No answer


Overall, 81% agree while 18% disagree.

#### c) Alberta's oil and gas industry is a world leader in emissions reduction

- 34% Strongly agree
- 31% Somewhat agree
- 17% Somewhat disagree
- 9% Strongly disagree
- 9% Don't know / No answer

Overall, 65% agree while 26% disagree.

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#### a) The policies of the federal government

27% Moderate factor



Average rating: 6.6 out of 10.




Overall, 68% support while 31% oppose.

How effective do you think efforts from the Government of Alberta have been in enhancing the reputation of Alberta's oil and gas industry outside of Alberta? Have they been ...



- 30% Somewhat effective
- 40% Not very effective, or
- 23% Not at all effective

Overall, 33% find them effective while 63% find them not effective.

Which of the following statements is closest to your view of how Alberta should address criticism of the environmental performance of the oil and gas industry?



- 61% Alberta needs to engage in dialogue and find ways to work cooperatively with environmental advocates to improve its environmental performance, or
- 35% Alberta needs to defend itself by fighting back against criticisms of the province's oil and gas industry
