


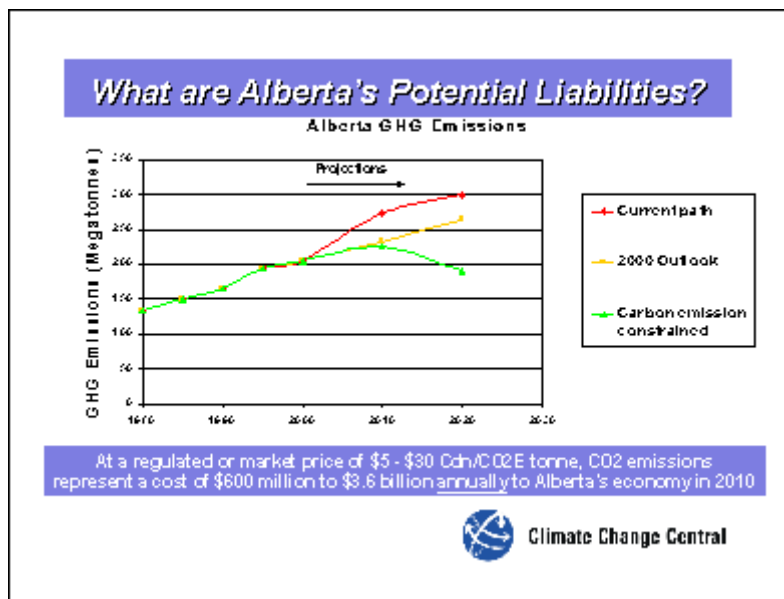

- b. does not include any increase in emissions associated with population or economic growth in the residential, commercial and transportation sectors.
