

# Polling Albertans on Renewable Energy 2026

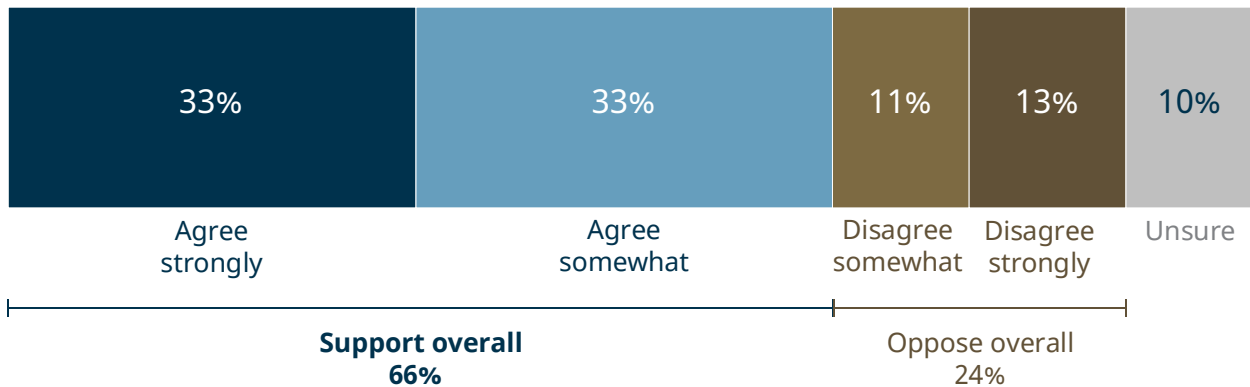
Conducted between April 27 and May  
6, 2026

Probe Research conducted an online survey with a representative sample of 1,484 Alberta adults between April 27 and May 6, 2026. All respondents were recruited from a national online panel (LEO). The sample has been weighted slightly by age, gender, region and educational attainment so it properly reflects Alberta's population, based on Census data. Because an online survey is a sample of convenience, no margin of error can be ascribed. Totals in this report may not add to exactly 100% due to rounding.

# Citizen support for renewable energy in communities

Most Albertans want to see more renewable energy projects built near where they live.

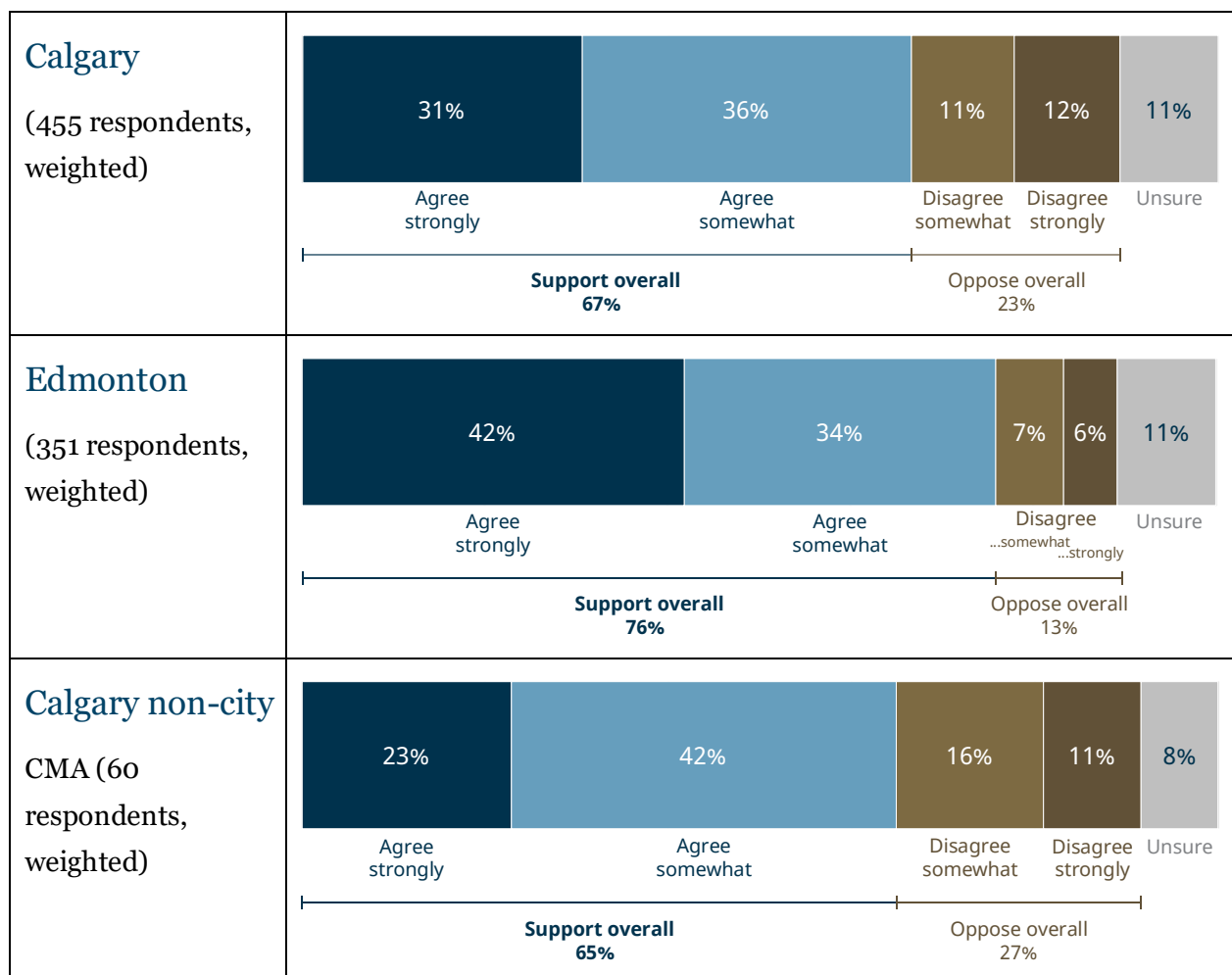
*Question: I would like to see more renewable energy projects, such as wind or solar, developed in or near the community where I live.*

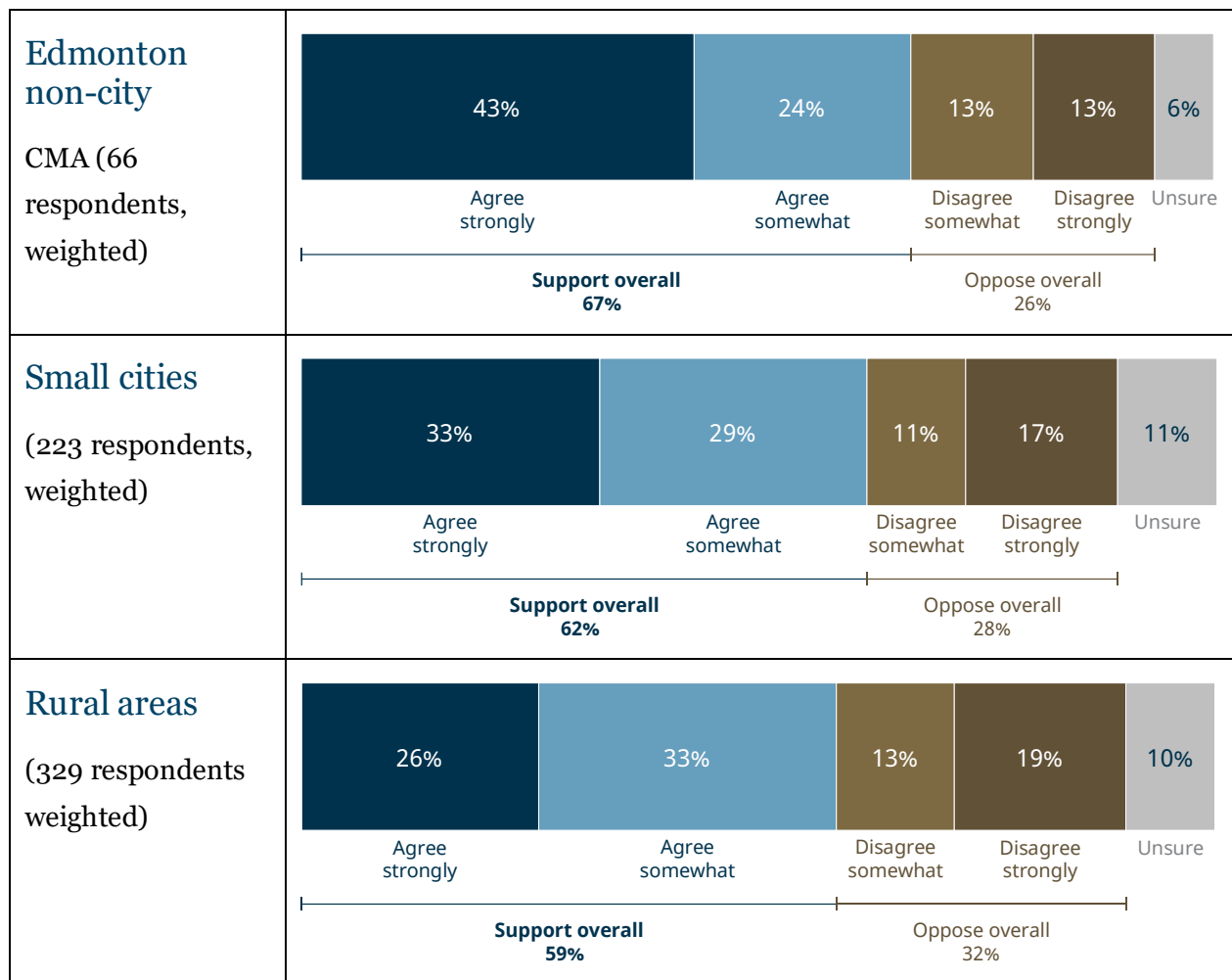


## Regional breakdown

There is majority support for more renewable energy projects to be built in **all regions** that were surveyed. Despite some suggestions in recent years that Albertans in rural areas oppose wind and solar development, there is strong support outside of the big cities, including in rural areas.
